The role:

The Community and Cohesion Manager will lead, develop, and oversee all aspects of the Foundation's community and cohesion work, ensuring that programmes and initiatives are strategically aligned with our mission to build belonging and improve lives. Reporting to the Head of Foundation, the postholder will provide leadership, vision, and operational management for a diverse portfolio of projects across youth inclusion, physical activity, well-being, and family support. They will manage a team of Leads and Community Activators, supporting them to deliver high-quality, inclusive, and impactful initiatives that address local needs, reduce inequalities, and foster stronger, more connected communities.

Main responsibilities & accountabilities:

- Provide strategic leadership and day-to-day management of the Community and Cohesion team, including the Youth Inclusion Lead, Physical Activity Lead, Well-being Lead, Early Years/Families Lead, and Community Activators.
- Work with the Head of Foundation to lead the design, implementation, and monitoring of community programmes that promote inclusion, health, well-being, and positive social outcomes.
- Ensure high standards of delivery across key initiatives such as Premier League Kicks, Holiday Activities and Food (HAF), SPACE, Family Hub programmes, Baby Bank, Weight Management, Golden Valiants, and Community Cupboard.
- Work with colleagues and external stakeholders to identify local needs and co-design programmes that respond effectively and creatively.
- Drive community engagement, ensuring that all programmes are inclusive and accessible, particularly for underrepresented and disadvantaged groups.
- Develop and maintain strong partnerships with local authorities, health providers, voluntary organisations, and other stakeholders to maximise reach and impact.
- Alongside the Head of Foundation, oversee budgets, funding bids, monitoring, and reporting requirements to ensure compliance and sustainability of programmes.
- Provide effective leadership and support to staff, promoting a positive culture, professional development, and performance excellence.
- Contribute to the wider Foundation strategy and represent the organisation at events, meetings, and forums, ensuring Port Vale Foundation is recognised as a leader in community cohesion.

Key skills and experience:

- Proven experience of managing teams and programmes within sport, community, or youth sectors.
- Strong leadership skills, with the ability to inspire and support staff working across multiple areas (youth, families, well-being, and physical activity).
- Demonstrated experience in programme design, monitoring, and evaluation.
- Excellent partnership-building skills with a track record of successful collaboration across sectors.
- Experience in securing funding, managing budgets, and delivering against financial targets.
- Strong understanding of issues affecting local communities, including youth inclusion, health inequalities, family support, and community cohesion.
- Ability to engage and inspire diverse groups, including vulnerable or hard-to-reach communities.
- Excellent organisational, communication, and problem-solving skills.
- Proactive, innovative, and resilient approach, with a passion for community development.
